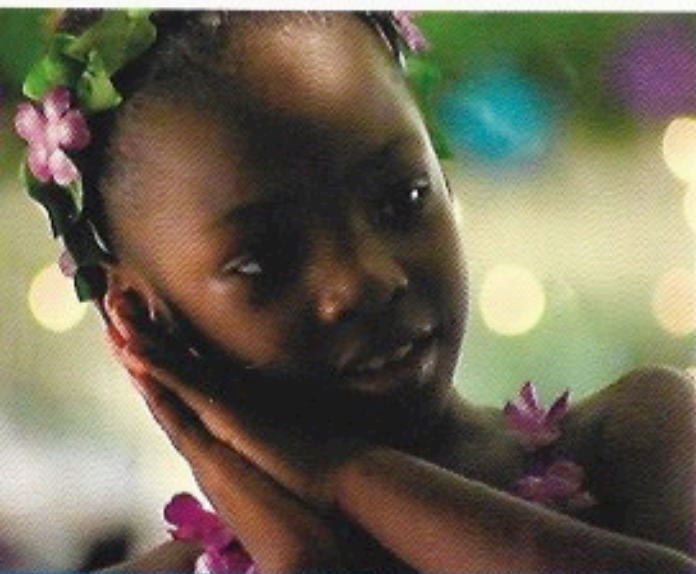


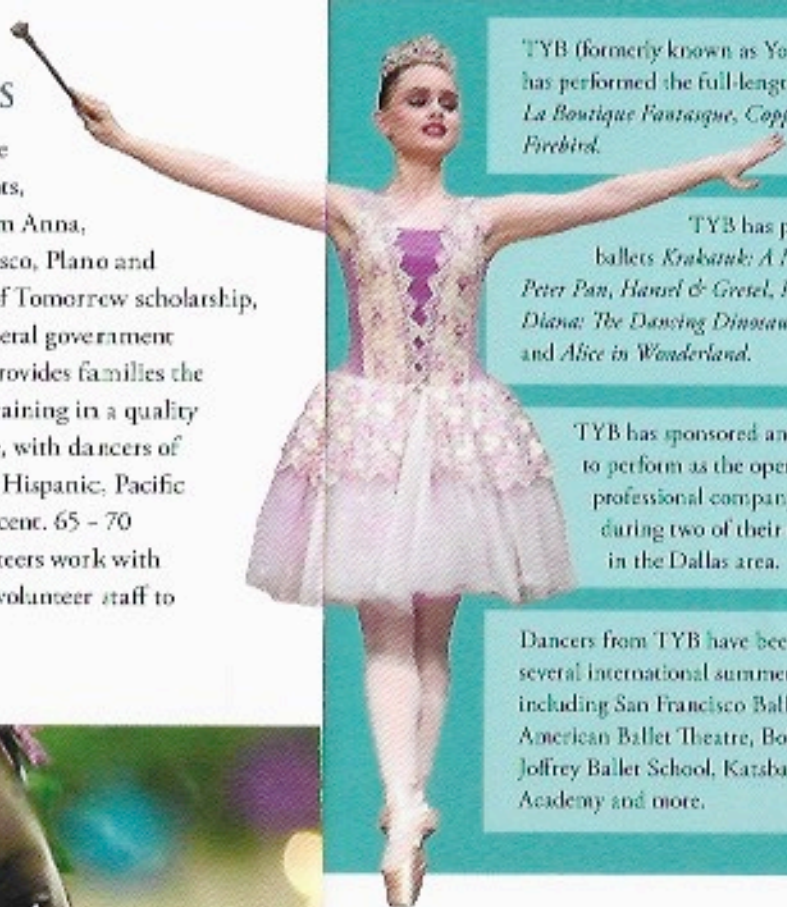
## DEMOGRAPHICS

Our company and school are primarily McKinney residents, with additional students from Anna, Melissa, Celina, Prosper, Frisco, Plano and Sherman. Our Ballet Stars of Tomorrow scholarship, using the scale set by the federal government for school lunch subsidies, provides families the opportunity for affordable training in a quality ballet school. TYB is diverse, with dancers of African American, Chinese, Hispanic, Pacific Island, Indian, and Thai descent. 65 - 70 dancers, and over 100 volunteers work with TYB company dancers and volunteer staff to support our productions.



## ALUMNI

Our first generation of TYB graduates desiring a career in dance have been accepted into traineeships with professional ballet companies or are dancing professionally.



TYB (formerly known as Youth Ballet of Texas) has performed the full-length ballets; *The Seasons*, *La Boutique Fantasque*, *Coppelia*, *Cinderella*, and *Firebird*.

TYB has performed the original ballets *Krakatau: A Nutcracker Proquel*, *Peter Pan*, *Hansel & Gretel*, *Pixie Holiday*, *Diana: The Dancing Dinosaur*, *Sanctus*, *Parade*, and *Alice in Wonderland*.

TYB has sponsored and been invited to perform as the opening act for the professional company, *Ballet Magnificenti* during two of their recent performances in the Dallas area.

Dancers from TYB have been accepted into several international summer training programs including San Francisco Ballet, Miami City Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, Bolshoi Ballet Intensive, Joffrey Ballet School, Katsbaan, Gelsey Kirkland Academy and more.

**OUR FOCUS** is both on bringing opportunities to those who would not normally be able to participate in ballet, to increase and celebrate the diversity and artistry within the art form, and provide chances for all children to experience the many benefits of ballet training. We seek to engage our dancers audiences, and artists through collaboration with orchestras, other non-profits and the community at large. Our board members are actively seeking to extend our influence and donor base, marketing that which makes TYB unique as a fine arts organization. To that end, we strive to move forward through attainable fundraising goals: increasing our reach in the community, our donor base, our scholarship support, and creating beautiful spaces for children to learn through a capital campaign for a state-of-the-art dance facility.
